

## PHP Faculty Council Comments on Strategic Plan Survey

(Please be advised that due to time constraints, not all Faculty Council members have had a chance to comment. Additional input will be solicited at the next meeting on Sept. 18).

1. The first concern expressed was in the design of the survey itself, forcing a choice of three items, even if the respondent did not want to choose three. Thus results should be interpreted with caution.
2. The second concern expressed was about the focus on a “medicentric” view of the health science center, not recognizing the missions of the other colleges, separate from supporting the College of Medicine mission.
3. The third concern was a lack of emphasis in the statements on the teaching mission of the colleges and the preparation of health professionals needed in today’s health care environment.
4. The final concern is for the syntax of the “we” and “they” become “us.” While the sentiment may be admirable, the shift from nominative to objective case is awkward.
