General Program Facts

- *Scientist-practitioner training* (focus on the integration of science and practice)
- *Clinical-science training* (training in science and practice; focus on academic/research career)
- First accredited by the American Psychological Association (APA) January 1, 1953
- 2001 American Psychological Association of Graduate Students (APAGS) Department of the Year
- 2007 American Psychological Association (APA) Departmental Award for Culture of Service in the Psychological Sciences
- Housed in HPNP Building (3rd Floor) and UF Health Science Center (Ground Floor)
- Graduates 12-15 PhD students per year; APA-accredited Internship program admits 12-13 interns per year
- 33 Core Faculty, 83 Graduate Students
- Offers an accredited general program in Clinical Psychology with two major tracks (Scientist-practitioner; Clinical-science) and advanced *specialty-specific training* in Neuropsychology, Neurorehabilitation, and Clinical Neuroscience; Clinical Child/Pediatric Psychology; Health Psychology; and Emotion Neuroscience and Psychopathology

Faculty Research Productivity (2006-2007)

- 71 peer-reviewed journal articles and 2 books
- 49 journal articles, 17 book chapters and 1 book “in press”.
- 124 presentations at national or international conferences; 27 state or local presentations
- Participated in newly awarded grants involving \$7.9 million dollars in direct costs

Student Productivity (2006-2007)

- 79% of students belong to a professional or research society
- 36% of students published in a peer-reviewed journal (Mean = 2.06)
- 69% had a paper or book chapter “in press”
- 84% published or presented their first year project at a national meeting
- 63% presented at a national or international meeting (Mean = 2.43)
- 87% were involved in grant supported research
- 22% were involved in formal teaching activities
- 100% of intern applicants obtained APA-accredited internship placements; 100% of students in past 7 years have obtained APA approved internships
